Four years ago, when 22-month old Sammy Sullivan suddenly died, it left his family struggling with how to keep his memory alive.

His parents, Joe and Brenda Sullivan decided to create Sammy Sullivan Charities as a way to honor him and give comfort to others in their time of need. Sammy's brief life has inspired a legacy of giving to others that spreads hope across the greater Tampa Bay region and beyond.

Sammy Sullivan Charities was established to help us raise and distribute funds. We partnered with Kids Charity of Tampa Bay, Inc., which is a non-profit 501 (c) (3), and have pledged to build and furnish a 12 bed home at the new Kids Charity Village in Brandon. Under construction now, this village will be a 60 bed, five home, emergency shelter for neglected children. Whether scared, confused, bruised or battered, the Sammy House will provide a safe haven for these children in their time of need.

We hold an annual golf tournament to raise funds for the charity and a major part of that event is the auction and golf awards ceremony.
